PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The La Gruta Chamber Orchestra provides a challenging program for school age musicians. The participants will gain ensemble skills and be introduced to orchestral repertoire.

The Chamber Orchestra welcomes students of string instruments: violin, viola, cello and double bass, or wind instruments: flute, clarinet, oboe, bassoon, trumpet, french horn and trombone.

The orchestra is conducted by Margaret Conyers and Heather Birrell. Margaret is an experienced teacher and performer playing in string quartets and orchestras. She now teaches privately and has taught in various schools where she also conducted instrumental ensembles. Heather is also an experienced teacher and performer. She teaches violin and viola privately, is a member of a string ensemble and performs with the Frankston Symphony Orchestra.

The students in La Gruta Chamber Orchestra perform annually with the Saturday Morning Music School Students, and are given opportunities to perform at Musical Society of Victoria events and with the Frankston Symphony Orchestra.
