Saturday Morning Music Program Details



Program Overview

This program is for children in prep to grade 4. It is designed to develop skills needed for instrumental studies through listening and responding to music by participating in singing, movement, drama and playing percussion instruments. In the second year of the program some children will be given the opportunity to make music through Recorder. Students with developed skills will be invited to join the extra class to begin studies in Violin or Keyboard.

Sing the Kodaly way

A fun singing based program that aims to teach children to sing independently and tunelessly. Children will start to read music through songs, games and rounds. Their voice is their first instrument.

Percussion the Orff way

An exciting percussion program where the children will learn to perform in an ensemble on a variety of instruments provided by the music school. Many musical concepts are explored like rhythm, pitch, beat and tempo using glockenspiels, xylophones, drums etc.

Now you can Dance

A performance based program using dance, the students will be encouraged to express themselves and produce on stage performances. Dance encourages rhythmic development and group experience.
